Re: Purpose of Crownbridge School

We hope you are all keeping safe and well in these difficult circumstances.

Government advice is that for safeguarding purposes if it is possible for pupils to be at home then they should be. This is to reduce social mixing which can continue to spread the coronavirus.

Crownbridge school is in the process of planning to offer a level of childcare to those families who cannot keep their children at home and feel their children need childcare and who are not at high risk.

School will remain closed to the majority of pupils this week.

Some parents have already agreed that their son/daughter are highly susceptible to the virus and will be safer at home for the foreseeable future. Currently we understand that there will not be a NHS nursing staff on site.

A minority of pupils will be offered provision based on a risk assessment basis. They will be telephoned directly by school to attend on Wednesday 25th March 2020 usual times.

These plans will be subject to change as plans develop and circumstances (eg staff available) change.
